# Lake Burley Griffin Regatta

## 15<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> October 2005

### Notice of Race

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc will apply. The event is category 7.
- 1.3 The rules of each competing class will apply.

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY.

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats recognised by the Trailable Yacht Association of NSW & ACT; and all dinghy, keelboat and multihull classes with yardsticks listed by Yachting Victoria.
- 2.2 An entry form must be completed to participate.

#### 3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Competitors shall register by completing an entry. The Registration shall be completed between 75 minutes and 15 minutes before the first warning signal of the scheduled starting sequence. Registration on 15<sup>th</sup> October shall suffice for racing on 16<sup>th</sup> October.
- 3.3 There will be one race each day for the following divisions:

Division 1	Trailable Yachts (CBH 685 and above)
Division 2	Trailable Yachts (CBH below 685)
Division 3	Dinghies (VYC yardstick below 117), International Flying Fifteen and 2.4mR classes
Division 4	Dinghies (VYC yardstick 117 and above)
Division 5	Off the beach catamarans
- 3.4 The first warning signal will be at 1400 hours on each race day.

#### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 1200 on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> October 2005 at either the YMCA Sailing Club or the Canberra Yacht Club.

#### 6 SCORING

- 6.1 Appendix A (RRS) will apply for scoring with the use of the Low Point System.
- 6.2 The calculation of regatta results will be based on the Yachting Victoria (VYC) yardstick for dinghies (including Flying Fifteen and 2.4mR) and catamarans; and the Trailable Yacht Association of NSW and ACT Trailable Yachts Class Basic Handicap (CBH) for trailable yachts.
- 6.3 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. No score shall be excluded; a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

#### 7 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

#### 8 PRIZES

- 8.1 Yachting ACT Lake Burley Griffin Regatta 2005 trophies will be awarded as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Trailable Yacht under 685 CBH
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Trailable Yacht 685 CBH and over
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Dinghy under 117 VYC (including Flying Fifteen and 2.4mR)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Dinghy 117 VYC and over
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Catamaran under 88 VYC
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Catamaran 88 VYC and over
- 8.2 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the race committee.

#### 9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authorities will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 10 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
